The United Way of Baroda funded higher education through INOX Group's CSR contributions for bright students in Gujarat.



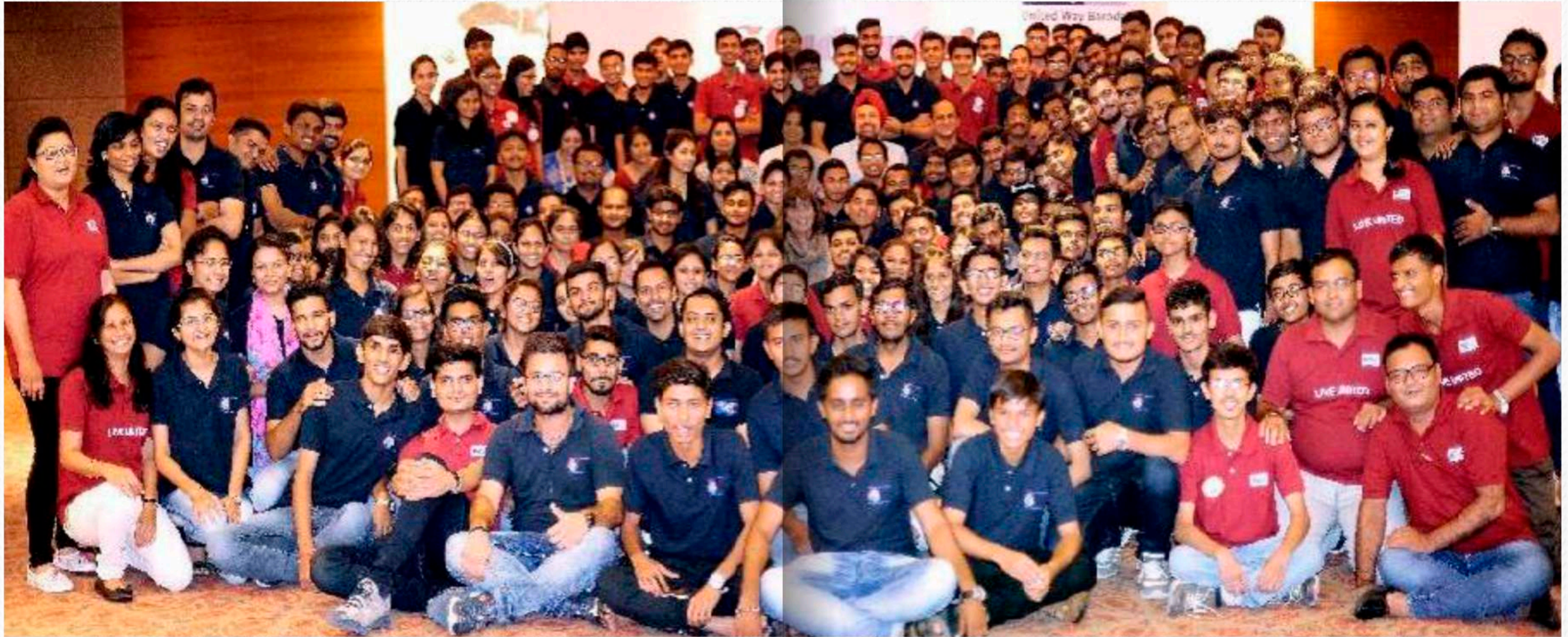
Friends of The Tribal Society ran One Teacher Schools in Chhattisgarh to educate 100 tribal children which were sponsored by INOX Group.

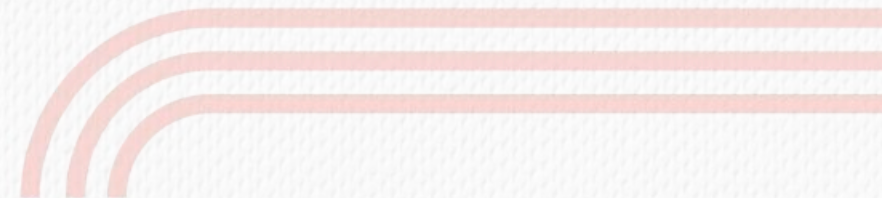

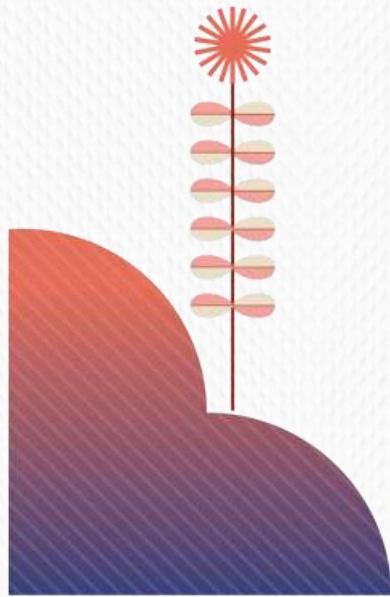




With INOX Group's support, Corvus Public Trust undertakes the initiatives of identifying and nurturing the next generation of student athletes from across India.

Buds Special School was provided with a bus for differently-abled children in Kannur, Kerala.

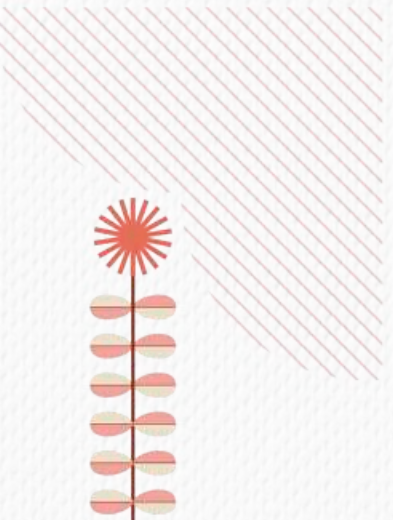
With Bombay Campion High School Society, INOX Group's CSR contributions supported quality education of talented students belonging to economically weaker sections.

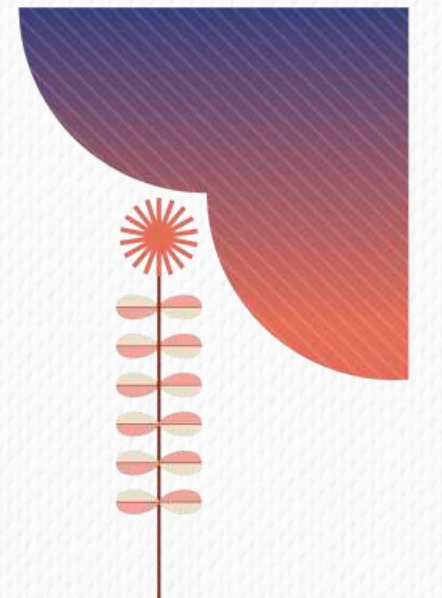
In collaboration with Quality Council of India, INOX Group supported the accreditation of 155 BMC Municipal Schools in a phased manner against national quality benchmarks.

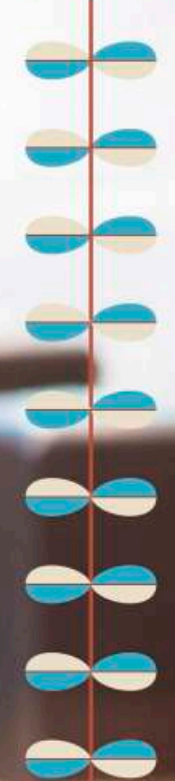
INOX Group empowered children in Vadodra Municipal Corporation schools with educational resources by distribution of workbooks to VMC School students.

ENHANCING HEALTH EMPOWERING COMMUNITIES





In collaboration with Balaji Heart Hospital & Diagnostic Centre, INOX Group has been working for the poor and the needy people of the society mainly in saving the precious lives of children suffering from congenital heart disease (CHD).

INOX Group enabled 20 cataract surgeries, supplied ambulances and took care of treatment procedures of senior citizens and low-income individuals through Blind Organization of India, helping prevent avoidable blindness.

Partnering with Catalysts for Social Action, INOX Group has contributed to improving health, hygiene and nutrition conditions in CCIs across 3 districts in Madhya Pradesh.





Uddip Social Welfare Society & INOX Group collaborated for a pilot project in Bhopal featuring 5+ specialized health activities for differently-abled children and parents.

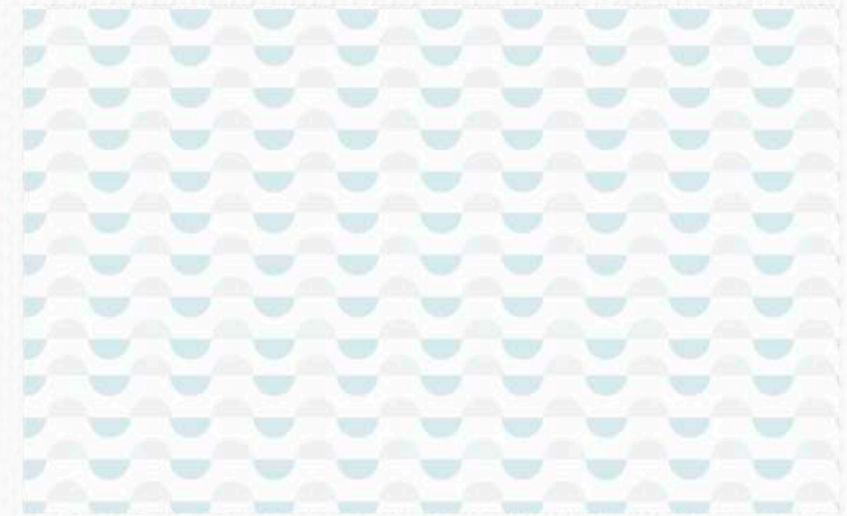
INOX Group facilitated critical equipment procurement at Charutar Arogya Mandal, enhancing care for neurosurgery patients from underserved communities.

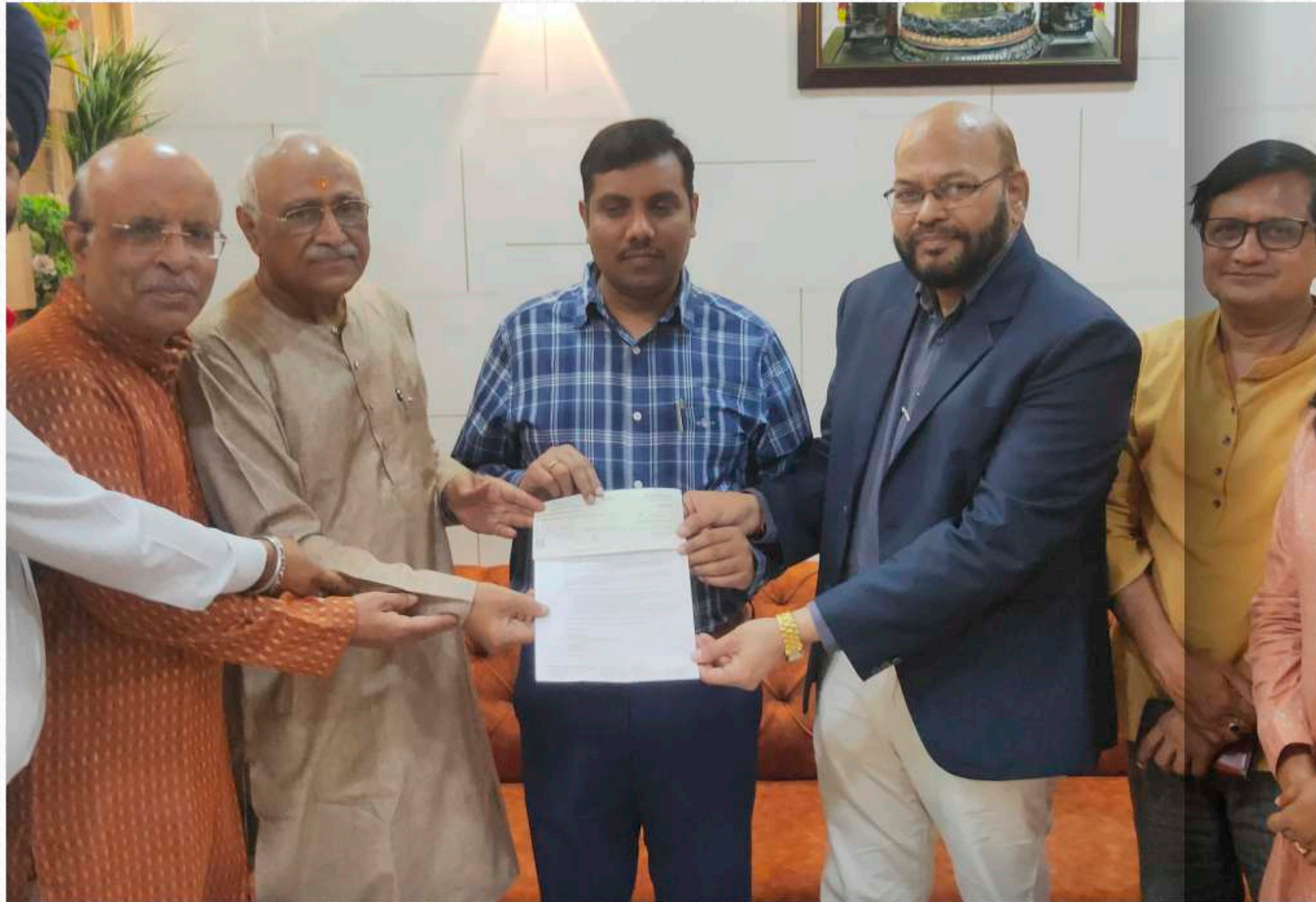

Kalaingar Centenary Super Speciality Hospital was supported with 3 electric vehicles by INOX Group - which is benefiting ~2,000 patients daily.



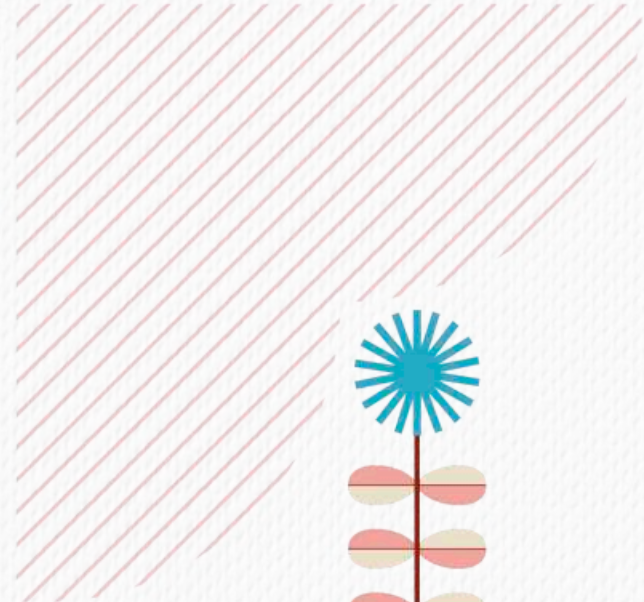


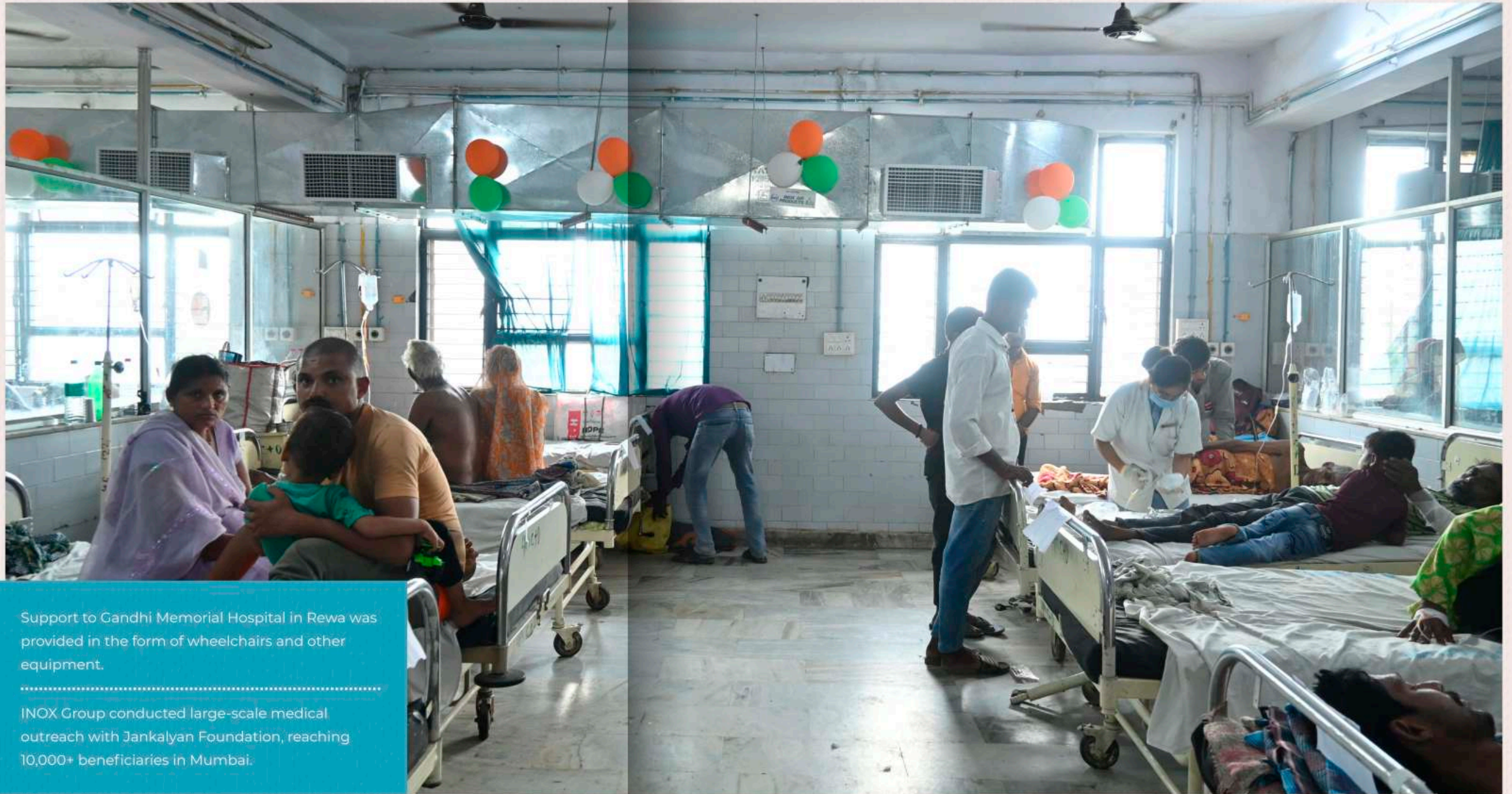

Support to Gandhi Memorial Hospital in Rewa was provided in the form of wheelchairs and other equipment.

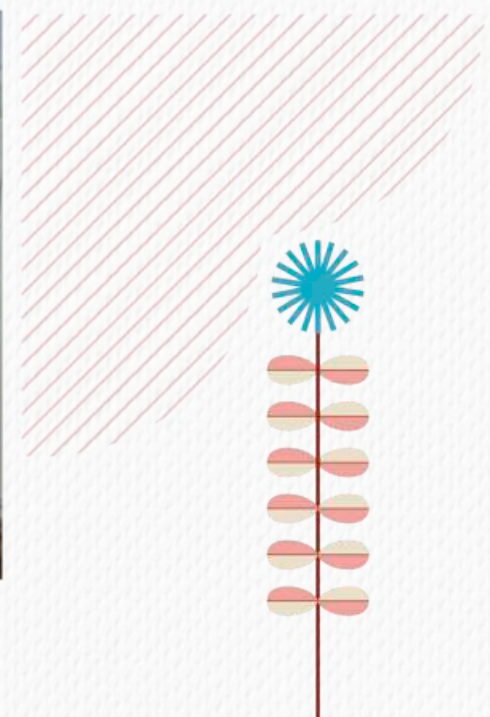
INOX Group conducted large-scale medical outreach with Jankalyan Foundation, reaching 10,000+ beneficiaries in Mumbai.

Support for Indraprastha Global Education and Research Foundation by INOX Group, contributing to the establishment of a medical hospital to provide quality healthcare.

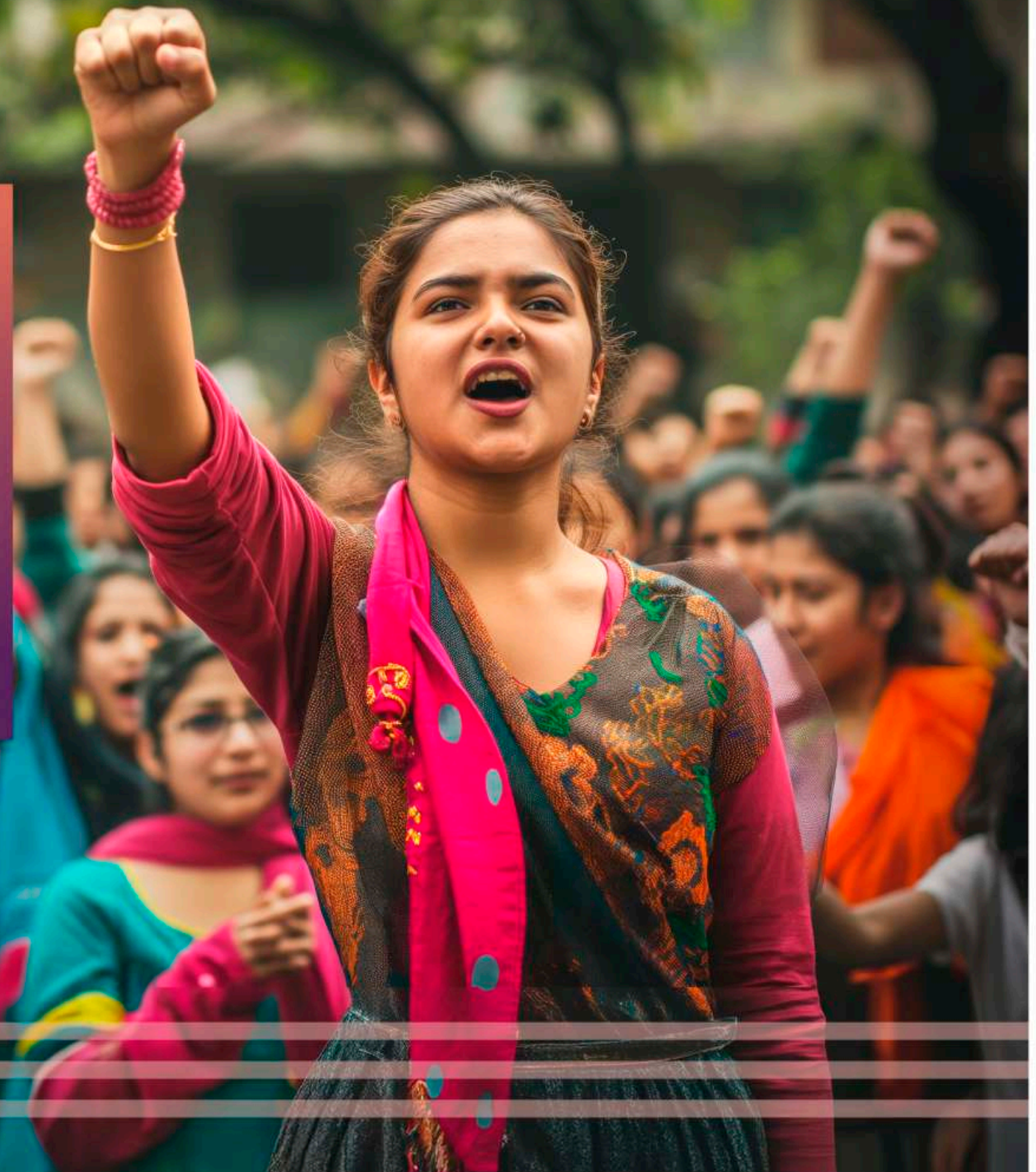

Under the Ekta Sashkt Kishori initiative by Red Brigade Lucknow, 4,000 adolescent girls across 50 schools/villages in Lucknow were being empowered by INOX Group through training in self-defense, health education, and social skills development, with support systems provided to help them pursue their aspirations and strengthen the fight against sexual and gender-based violence.



In collaboration with the All India Foundation of Deaf Women (AIFDW) in Delhi, INOX Group funded vocational training, rehabilitation support, and job placement assistance for hearing-impaired women, with both initiatives focusing on skill-building, safety, rehabilitation, and creating sustainable livelihood opportunities.



In collaboration with ITM University, the SPARK initiative in Baroda empowers women to pursue welding, providing rigorous training to become skilled professional welders.

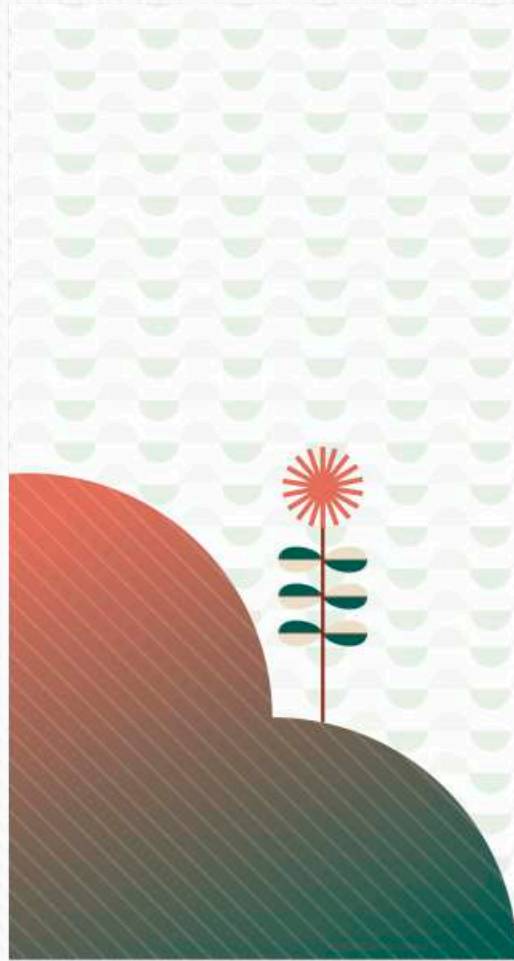




NATION BUILDING

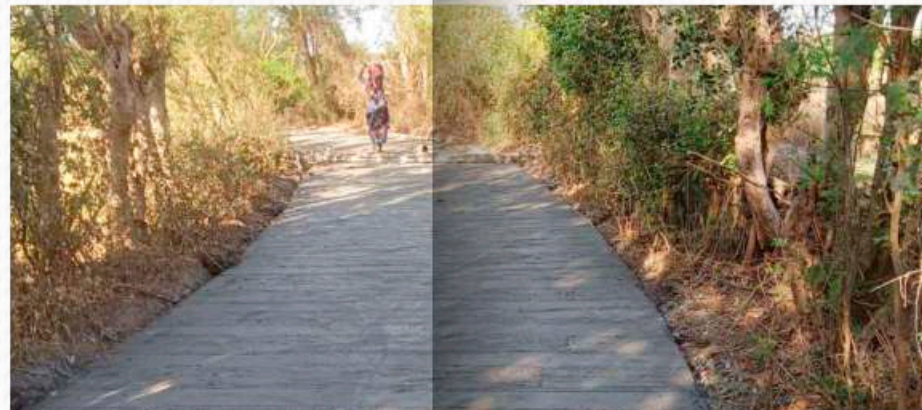
RURAL DEVELOPMENT

STRENGTHENING INDIA'S GRASSROOTS



In collaboration with Eklavya Swavalamban Trust, INOX Group is undertaking a project in Palghar aimed at providing essential infrastructure and renewable energy systems, including the installation of 5 kVA on-grid and 5 kVA off-grid solar installation & expansion of existing buildings to accommodate 20 trainees for skill development. The project aims to enhance the welfare of tribal communities and support self-reliance through renewable energy and vocational training.



Hindush Foundation transformed and redeveloped Nichole village, Wada, Palghar through CSR contributions from INOX Group. It includes Zilla Parishad school's infrastructure redevelopment such as construction of sanitary block, repairing of School Compound wall, leveling of playground and much more.

With United Way of Baroda, INOX Group contributed towards the upliftment of deprived communities in Gujarat in terms of education, health, income stability, etc. underprivileged communities in the district of Vadodara

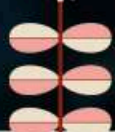
In Simej, INOX Group worked with Government Bodies to develop roads in the surrounding areas.





RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT

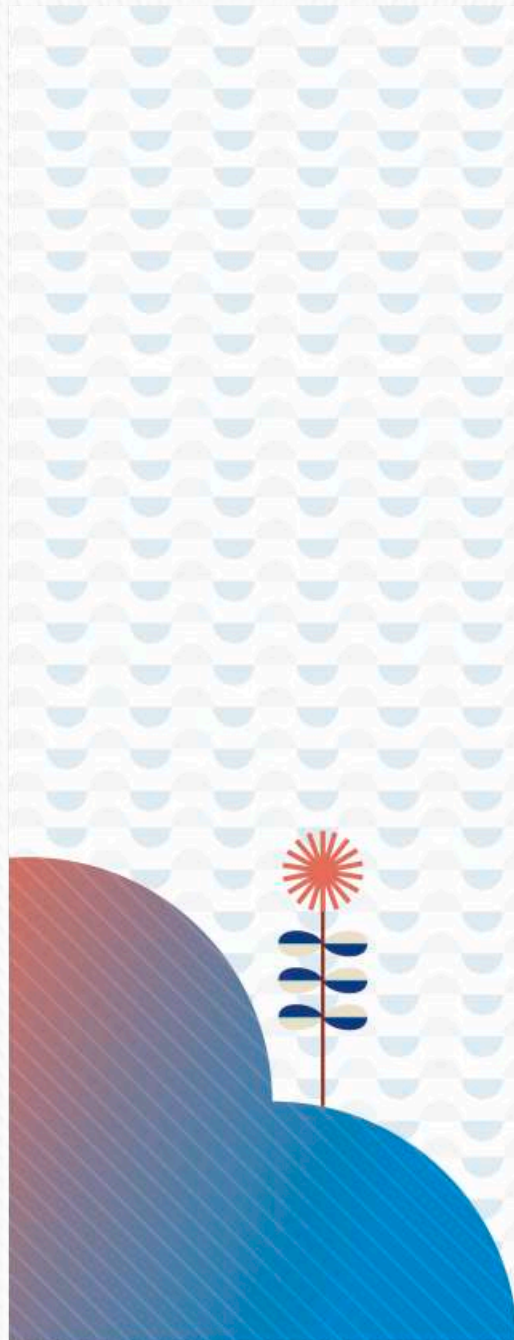
INOX Group propels India's journey towards technological self-reliance through focused investments in research and infrastructure at premier institutions. Projects focused on India's capabilities in cryogenics, nanotechnology, clean energy, and high-precision scientific instrumentation are strengthening the nation's innovation ecosystem, fueling discovery, and laying the foundation of the future.



PIONEERING RESEARCH AND INNOVATION THROUGH STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIPS

INOX Group established the INOX Quantum Materials Lab at the Indian Institute of Science (IISc) to advance research in semiconductor and quantum technologies. Located within the Centre for Nano Science and Engineering (CeNSE), the lab focuses on developing topological semiconductors—an essential class of materials required for fault-tolerant quantum computing and the future of scalable quantum technologies.

At IIT Delhi, multiple CSR-funded research projects are being supported by INOX Group across diverse scientific areas, including a project that involves an experimental setup to study the flow behavior and stratification of hydrogen-natural gas mixtures in gas pipelines.

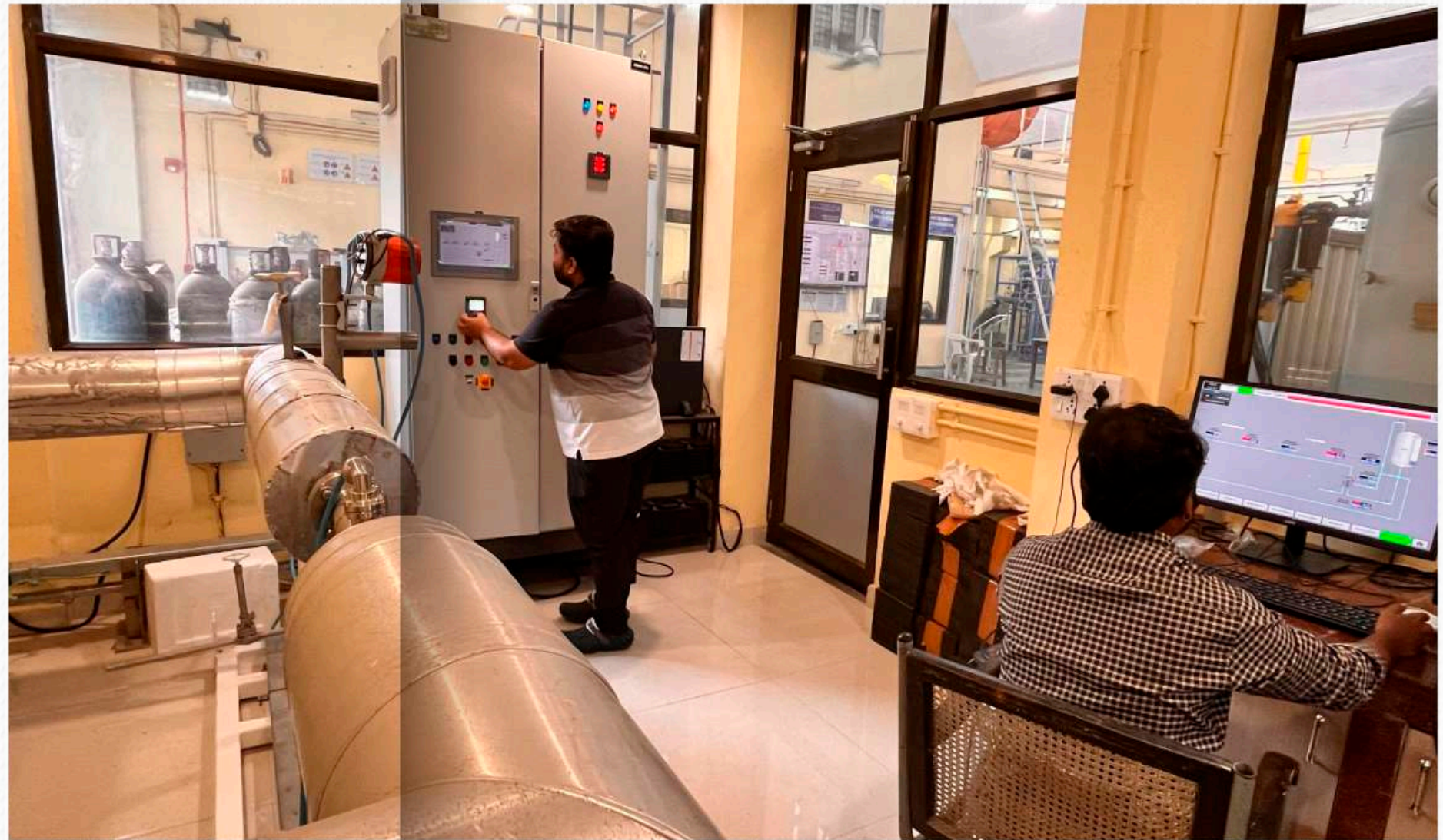




Additionally, the construction and repair of the existing Energy Innovation Laboratory is underway, while another project focuses on the electronics, optoelectronics, and thermoelectric properties of 2D nanomaterials using a Cryogenic Probe Stage. Another initiative is dedicated to developing a High-Capacity Deionized (DI) Water System for scientific and industrial applications. Furthermore, two high-end research setups are being established, focusing on Inductively Coupled Plasma Mass Spectrometry (ICP-MS) and ICP-OES, which are critical for advanced materials analysis and trace-level chemical detection.



At IIT Bombay, INOX Group is contributing for the development of a Cryogenic Research Facility, which will strengthen research in ultra-low temperature science and technology.





ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY

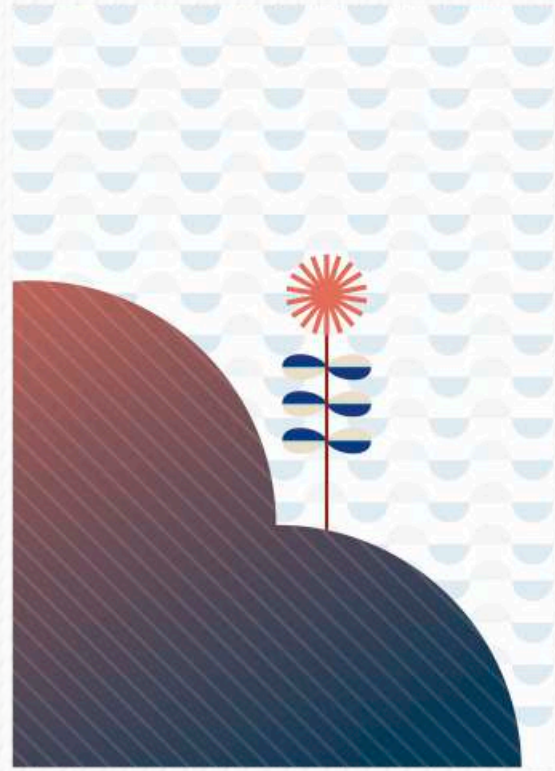


GREENING THE FUTURE WITH A SUSTAINABLE INDIA
